

Dubber goes live in Europe, UK with 'revolutionary' solution for telcos

Listed Australian communications solutions provider, Dubber, has released its native cloud call recording platform in the UK and European markets, claiming it opens up a “revolutionary way” for telecommunications carriers to supply call recording and associated technologies to their customer base.

In May, **Dubber** (ASX:DUB) was accredited for interoperability with Broadsoft unified communications platform, a major player in the market and the network deployed in over 600 telecommunications service providers worldwide.

Following the accreditation, Dubber released its Dubber Labs for Broadworks which enables telcos to connect and test recording across an entire user base within hours and at no cost.

Dubber managing director, Steve McGovern, says the release of the platform in the

UK & Europe comes off the back of the company's European Broadsoft roadshow "from which we have had a positive response from a number of prominent telcos who are currently engaged in the testing process."

"This represents potential customer opportunities which run into the hundreds of thousands by way of monthly subscriptions and, also, a unique 'on demand' capability.

"Europe is a key market for Dubber and this is the first step which should see re-sellers and telco partners providing Dubber recording on a previously unmatched scale."

McGovern said that while the Dubber platform is built to scale across a global rollout, the company continues to experience organic growth in the local SME market and expects this to be a continuing trend.
