Drilling results showing promise

A NORTH-WEST mining hopeful has reported encouraging results from the first five holes of a diamond drilling program.

Elementos Limited said it was very encouraged by results from two of the holes at its Cleveland Project, in a historic mining area near ghost town Luina.

Results from the two holes had “potential to extend the open cut mineral resource at two of the main tin-copper lode systems defined at Cleveland”.

The diamond drilling program started in August.

“The initial drill results received are an encouraging start to the program, highlighting the potential for an incremental increase in the existing open cut resources at Cleveland,” Elementos chief executive Chris Creagh said.

Twenty-eight drill holes are planned as part of the program.
